Micro-projects.

Thanks to a donation, we were able to invest a little more in a few projects that were already underway and showing good results. This donation also allowed us to launch other projects we had planned for this year.

By setting up these small-scale projects, people in our churches are enabled to earn their own income. This makes them independent of aid and allows them to buy food and drink, send their children to school, and pay their own rent.

In the first week of May, final exams begin for Br. Jake Agyir, our medical student at the University of Armenia. He hopes to return to Ghana in early June 2026 to work as a general practitioner in one of Accra's hospitals.

So, all in all, a positive start to the first four months.

As the board, we are very pleased that, after so many attempts, we have finally succeeded in bringing Apostle Cennick to the Netherlands. God willing, he will travel to the Netherlands on May 15.

The purpose of his visit is to strengthen our relationship with the supporting churches, individuals, and businesses. As the board, we also hope to exchange ideas with him regarding the ministry and the future.

Cennick has been invited by various participating churches to speak and teach the Bible, and he will also be involved in several other activities.

Currently, Apostle Ronny Vaarnold of Houses of Hope Ministry Int. Suriname is also in the Netherlands. He was originally scheduled to come to Ghana this year for the Easter conference, but circumstances prevented him from coming. We are glad that we can meet him here in the Netherlands as well!
